To show our appreciation, the PTA at Malibu will be awarding a scholarship in his memory this spring.

The *John Prine Memorial Scholarship* will be in the amount of a \$500.00 scholarship. It will be awarded to candidates who complete this application and meet the other prerequisites contained herein. The Parent Teacher Association of Malibu Elementary School donated the money that will be awarded. The recipient will be chosen after careful consideration of his/her character, civic participation, scholarship, and financial need. The order of importance in the selection process will be left to the discretion of the selection committee.

Philosophy Statement

The Scholarship Committee (comprised of 3 members of the Malibu PTA – a Malibu teacher PTA member and 2 Board Officers) affirms its commitment to the objective of the National Congress of Parents and Teachers. As part of the commitment to secure for every child the highest advantages of physical, mental, social, and spiritual education, we believe the applicants are better served if this scholarship does not restrict its potential recipients as to the choice of careers.

Prerequisites

1. Applicant must have been enrolled at Malibu Elementary School for a minimum of two years, three years at a VBCPS middle school and two years at a VBCPS high school to apply for this scholarship.
2. Applicant must be a graduating senior from a Virginia Beach high school.
3. By the following fall, candidates must plan to enter an accredited college, university (2 or 4 year) as a full-time student.
4. Applicant must have maintained a grade point average of C or better for the past four semesters.

Financial Disposition

The PTA will pay the amount of the scholarship directly to the college or university. It will be the responsibility of the recipient to notify the PTA Treasurer when the payment is to be made
